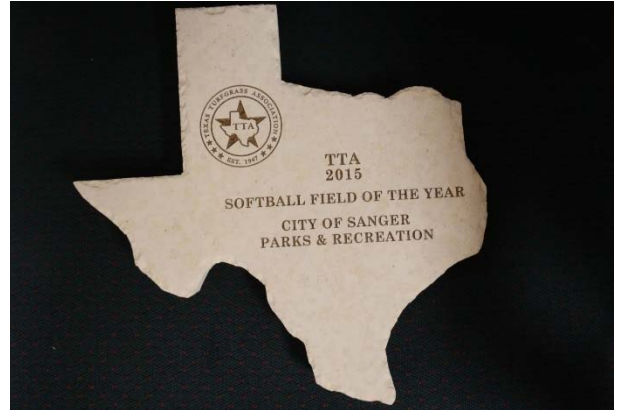


Sanger Parks & Recreation Department Receives Statewide Award

The City of Sanger was recently presented with an award from the Texas Turfgrass Association (TTA) during their annual conference held in San Antonio. Each year, the Texas Turfgrass Association honors those who have an outstanding sports field, golf course renovation, lawn care, etc. These individuals are recognized for going above and beyond to make sure their complex is one of the best in the state.



The Parks and Recreation department received the 2015 Softball Field of the Year award for the Porter Sports Complex. “Winning this award is a validation of our department’s commitment to providing quality parks for the community of Sanger,” said Parks and Recreation Director Jim Berman.

Funded by the Sanger Development Corporation, the Porter Sports Complex was completed in 2011 as a multipurpose sports facility and hosts approximately 250 events per year. Located just off Interstate Highway 35, it is the show piece of the City of Sanger. With softball and soccer as its main focus, the complex offers a 1 ¼ mile walking trail, fishing pond, open space, playground, and picnic areas.
