

Sanger Prepares For Growth

The City of Sanger has started the work on major utility upgrades along the west side of I-35. Water and sewer lines will be extended from FM 455 to north of Belz Rd. The estimated cost of this project is \$750,000 with an anticipated completion date of January 2016. These upgrades will ensure that services are in place to accommodate future development. “Sanger is positioned on the path of growth,” Economic Development Director Alina Ciocan said. “Our goal is to be prepared to respond quickly to the growing needs of the real estate market.” Utility upgrades are also planned for the east side of I-35. These will include extending the water and sewer lines from FM 455 to View Rd.
